This is the only way out of suffering, if we believe — to go through the unknown with the Unknown, and a sense of awe and wonder at the Mystery

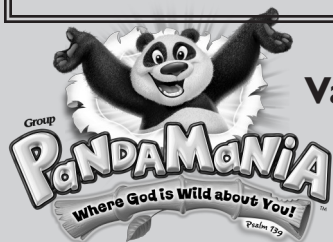
Our life is held, and protected and nourished INSIDE the Ultimate mystery. Rejoice in that!

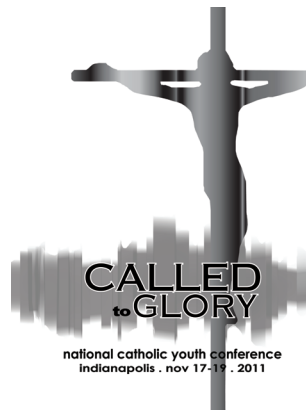

What is a Sponsor?

A sponsor is an active Catholic that is willing to be a companion to someone going through the RCIA process. As they get acquainted they listen, answer questions, pray together, and connect them with the parish. Sponsors find their role to be one that enriches and deepens their own faith as well. It is a very rewarding experience. As one sponsor said, "I am learning and growing at a better pace than if I had not sponsored someone. It is very exciting to hear the questions they ask and to see them evolve through the process." Sponsors are not meant to have all the answers (in fact, it is better if they don't).
